- Educate voters on policies and candidates' positions.


How we'll do it:

AFFORDABLE RI AGENDA

Access to Quality Healthcare

- ✔ Easier access to low-cost care through the state.
- ✔ Raise wages for frontline healthcare workers.

Higher Wages

- ✔ Full-time work should support a stable life.
- ✔ Raise the state minimum wage to \$20/hour by 2027.

Affordable, Safe, & Fair Housing

- ✔ **Affordable:** Rent increases capped at 4% annually, affordable utilities, and continued investments in green energy to meet Act on Climate goals.
- ✔ **Safe:** Lead safety and enforce rental registry laws.
- ✔ **Fair:** Landlords must have just-cause to evict tenants.

Universal Pre-K & Affordable Childcare

- ✔ Publicly funded pre-K for all 3- and 4-year-olds.
- ✔ Expanded eligibility for childcare subsidies.

Tax the Rich

- ✔ Individuals earning over \$640,000 pay an additional 3% on income above that threshold.
- ✔ Estimated \$200 million to invest in public services.
